#### Fabian Jimenez Outstanding Competitor of the Year

Awarded his 1<sup>st</sup> Dan in Karate at the age of 10, and named the "Karate Kid" of Victoria, TX, Sensei Fabien Jimenez was the Grand Champion of the final Texas Four Season Karate Championship in 2018. Now a 4<sup>th</sup> Dan, he has more than 100 first-place finishes in his short career as a martial artist and was the Junior Kata Wars Champion in 2021 He is also a 2021 recipient of the James Woodson Natural Fighter Award and Ralph Jaschke Memorial Dragon Image Award.

#### Gary Alvarez, Jr. BJJ Instructor of the Year

A recipient of the 2020 Master World's Silver Medal, Master Alvarez is a Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu Black Belt with more than 14 years of experience in martial arts. A member of Budo Kai International, GM Chris Pollman is an 8<sup>th</sup> Dan in Goju-Ryu. He distinguished martial arts career also includes training in Kubodo, the Joe Lewis Fighting System, and 11 years at the Karate College. GM Pollman is also an honorary 8<sup>th</sup> Dan in Aibuijutsu-Ryu. At 73, he is still actively teaching at the school that bears his name, Chris Pollman Karate Academy in Weatherford OK, where he teaches Okinawan Karate, Goju-Ryu, and Sho Rei Kan.

#### Jerry Lee Potts Legacy of Excellence (Posthumus)

Sensei Jerry Potts started his karate journey in 1968 in Wado-Ryu. He was privileged to train under GM Hironori Ohtsuka and Jiro-Ohtsuka, the second Grandmaster of Wado Ryu. Sensei Potts went on to earn a 7<sup>th</sup> Dan in Wado-ryu and was influential in the expansion of the Art well beyond the borders of Tennessee to the United States. He also successfully competed internationally. Sensei Potts was an active member of Karate for Christ International, offering free classes to students, and training thousands of students over his 52-year teaching career. Sensei Potts passed away in 2020 leaving a lasting legacy that lives on through the students who have become instructors in Wado Ryu.

#### Duke Ali Shariff-Bey Golden Life Award

GM Duke Ali Shariff-Bey started his martial arts career in Goju-Ryu over 50 years ago and has expanded to include Black Belts in Do Hap Sool, Taekwondo, and Aiki-Ju-Budo-Ryu. He is a highly desired Law Enforcement Self-Defense Instructor and has been teaching Women's Self-Defense classes at Prairie View A&M University for 20 years. After retiring from the Air Force, he began a distinguished career as a Texas Peace Officer and has earned numerous certifications, and today still serves and teaches advanced combating fighting. He is a founding member of the Jai Yen Yen System of Martial Arts and the Brotherhood of Veteran Warriors.

#### Stephen M. Senne Lifetime Achievement Award (Posthumus)

GM Stephen Senne started his martial arts career in the 1960s and having earned his Nidan, he was personally appointed an official Branch Chief of the Kyo-Kushin-Kaikan by Sosai Masutatsu Oyama. He was also a direct student of GM Donald Buck, founder of the Tiger Karate School and American Kyojushin Karate Organization. Known as "The Leopard", GM Senne invested over 60 years of his life teaching and expanding the Art of Kyokushin through the instructors and students who now perpetuate his legacy. GM Stephen Senne passed away in June 2022. He received his honorary Judan from the Grading Council of the Kyokushin Karate School of the Serpent, a fitting honor to a life well-lived.

#### Michael Sullenger Golden Life Award

Ranked the #1 AKS Kata Competitor in 1973 and 1974, GM Michael Sullenger was a force to be reckoned with in the tournament circuit. Now in his seventh decade in martial arts, he currently holds a 10<sup>th</sup> Dan in Chon-Do-Kwon, an American Karate System. He has also trained in Judo, Aiki-Jutsu, and Shotokan. GM Sullenger is a member of the American Karate Association and the South Texas Karate Black Belt Association. Today, he teaches private lessons to individuals and the law enforcement community.

Andy Kimura is the only student whom Taky Kimura deemed worthy of a full instructorship and a Rank 6 in Jun Fan Gung Fu. Sifu Kimura has shown an impressive mastery of Jun Fan Gung Fu / Jeet Kune Do and has been put through the rigorous training required to obtain this unique distinction. He was a board member of the Bruce Lee Foundation, a non-profit organization formed for the sole purpose of preserving and perpetuating Bruce Lee's art and philosophy. Currently, he is an advisor for the Bruce Lee Foundation.

#### Lloyd Craft Lifetime Achievement Award

Great Grandmaster Lloyd Craft, at age 75, is still making a difference in the lives of others. He is a second-generation student of the legendary William Chow, and currently holds a rank of 10<sup>th</sup> Dan in Shaolin Kenpo, as well as Black Belt Rankings in Kajukenbo and Modern Arnis. Martial artist, fight choreographer, stuntman, actor, and motivational speaker, GM Mike Stone started training in Shorin-Ryu while stationed at Fort Chaffee in Fort Smith AR, earning his black belt in only 6 months. Nicknamed "The Animal" for his ferocity in the ring, he won the sparring title at the first-ever International Grandchamipionships in Long Beach CA in 1964, before. He then went on to enjoy an illustrious career fighting, amassing a record of 91 consecutive wins. GM Stone has also spent a number of years in the film industry, choreographing, directing, and even starring in fight scenes for a number of well-known actors.

GM Stone has also authored several books and toured as a motivational speaker for some time. He is also infamously known as the man who "stole Elvis Presley's wife", Priscilla. In 1985, Stone sold all his possessions and moved to an isolated island in the Philippines where he has his wife Taina live a quiet and peaceful life.
